Veterans

From \$2,400 to \$9,600

Non-Veteran Groups - Pending Federal Reauthorization

From \$1,200 in one year to \$9,000 over two years

Three Simple Steps to Apply

1. Complete IRS Form 8850, Pre-Screening Notice and Certification Request for the Work Opportunity Tax Credit, by the date of the job offer
2. Complete the USDOL form ETA 9061-Individual Characteristics Form
3. Mail the signed and dated IRS and USDOL forms no later than the 28th calendar day after the new employee starts work to:
